

## Stripy crochet scarf



### Materials

150g Double knitting wool (50g in three contrasting colours)  
4mm crochet needle

### Size

Approx 11cm wide and 210cm long (excluding tassels)

### Instructions

Make 230 chain. (Hint: make the chain loose so the scarf doesn't pucker at the edge).

1<sup>st</sup> row – Using first colour, treble crochet into fourth chain. One treble into each chain to end.

2<sup>nd</sup> row – Change to second colour and make three chain. One treble into each treble to end.

3<sup>rd</sup> row – Change to third colour and make three chain. One treble into each treble to end.  
Repeat first three rows three more times (twelve rows in total).

Sew in ends.

### Fringe

To make the fringe cut 32 20cm lengths of each three colours by wrapping the wool around a piece of card 10cm wide and then cutting the wool at one end. Take four strands of wool in first colour and fold in half. Using a crochet hook pull the stands through at end of scarf between first and second row so you have loop. Pass the ends of the stands through the loop and pull tight. Repeat for each row at both ends using matching colours as appropriate.
