

# Dodecahedron mobile by Clare Worrall



## Materials

Oddments of 4ply yarn (eg sock yarn)

Set 4 double pointed needles size 2.5 mm

Polyester toy stuffing.

## Approx size

30cm across

## Instructions

### Point 1

Cast on 50 sts. Join into a round being careful not to twist. Place marker at beg of round.

\*Knit 4 rounds.

Round 5: (k8, k2tog) five times (45 sts).

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 10: (k7, k2tog) five times (40 sts)

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 15: (k6, k2tog) five times (35 sts)

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 20: (k5, k2tog) five times (30 sts)

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 25: (k4, k2tog) five times (25 sts)

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 30: (k3, k2tog) five times (20 sts)

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 35: (k2, k2tog) five times (15 sts)

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 40: (k1, k2tog) five times (10 sts)

Knit 4 rounds.

Round 45: k2tog five times (5 sts)

Break yarn, thread through remaining sts, pull tight and finish off with a couple of small securing stitches and darn in end.

### Point 2

Pick up and knit 10 sts from the bottom edge of point 1 then cast on 40 sts and join into a round taking care not to twist. Place a marker at the beginning of the round. Then continue as for Point 1 from \* to end.

### Point 3

Pick up and knit 10 sts from the bottom edge of Point 2, 10 sts from Point 1, then cast on 30 sts and join into a round taking care not to twist. Place a marker at the beginning of the round. Then continue as for Point 1 from \* to end.

Work 2 more Point 3's and then you will have covered 4 edges of Point 1.

### Point 4

Pick up and knit 10 sts from the bottom edge of Point 2, 10 sts from Point 1, then another 10 sts from another Point 2 cast on 20 sts and join into a round taking care not to twist. Place a marker at the beginning of the round. Then continue as for Point 1 from \* to end.



If you now stuff each point your star should look something like this. You are now half way.

Continue picking up stitches from the bottom edges of the existing points. The first will be the same as Point 3, the next three will be the same as Point 4, the final one will be:

### Point 5

Pick up and knit 40 sts from neighbouring points then cast on 10 sts. and join into a round taking care not to twist. Place a marker at the beginning of the round. Then continue as for Point 1 from \* to end.

When you get to here you will just have one pentagonal hole left so stuff your shape as firmly as you want, then finish off by working a final Point 5 which you can stuff through the gap which you should have left between two of the points. Finish off by stitching the two remaining edges and voila!
