

# WOOLLY THINKING KNITTING PATTERN

## Simple cable scarf pattern



### Requirements

5.5mm needle

400g British breeds oiled aran wool

### Approx size

20cm wide and 160cm long

### Abbreviations

C3B = slip next 3 stitches onto a cable needle and move to the back of work. Knit the next 3 stitches as normal, then knit the 3 stitches from the cable needle.

### Pattern

Cast on 45 stitches

Row 1: Knit all stitches

Row 2: K6, P6, \*K3\*, P6\*, repeat from \* to \* three more times, K6

Row 3: As row 1

Row 4: As row 2

Row 5: K6, \*C3B, K3\*, repeat from \* to \* 3 times, K3

Row 6: As row 2

Repeat Rows 1 - 6 until your scarf is the desired length.

To make a wide scarf cast on extra multiples of 9 stitches and repeat \* to \* the appropriate number of times.
