

Easy knit cowl scarf with fingerless mitts



Materials

2 x 100g skeins Manos Del Uruguay pure wool
5.5mm knitting needle

Cowl scarf

Cast on 25 stitches.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) until you have used up one skein of wool but leaving enough yarn to cast off. Cast off and sew in ends. Sew the two ends of the scarf together to make your cowl scarf.

Fingerless mitts (make two)

Cast on 26 stitches

Row 1: K2, *P2, K2, repeat from * to end

Row 2: P2, *K2, P2, repeat from * to end

Repeat each of these two rows 5 more times (12 rows in total)

Row 13: Knit to end

Row 14: Purl to end

Continue in stocking stitch for 27 more rows or until mitten is desired length.

Cast off in purl and sew in ends.

Sew up the mitten leaving a hole for your thumb.
